FAQ

- What kind of socks and leggings can my child wear?

Your child may wear any color or pattern leggings or socks

- What do you mean by solid?

Your child may wear a top or bottom that is one color including collars, cuffs and sleeves. Any design, such as stripes, sparkles, acid wash, tie dye render the garment not solid and therefore, not in dress code.

- Can my child wear denim?

Girls may wear denim skirts as long as they are a solid color.

- Can there be a logo on the shirt?

All JEC logos are appropriate. Any other logos should be small (smaller than a quarter).

- Does my child's jacket or sweatshirt need to be in dress code colors?

*Jackets or sweatshirts that are **only** worn outside do not have to conform to dress code. Any jacket worn in the classroom must be solid and comply with dress code colors. Your child may want a solid sweatshirt to keep in the classroom.*
